



Local Notice to Mariners 03 / 2026

Ships Gear

Vessels are required to obtain prior permission from Vessel Traffic Services (VTS) before swinging any on board gear out over the water during a port call.

On board gear includes, but is not limited to:

- On board cranes;
- Stability pontoons;
- Davits;
- Gangways;
- Any other on board equipment that protrudes and extends out over the side of a vessel.

The following activities require prior approval from Vessel Traffic Services (VTS):

- Launching or moving lifeboats, rescue boats, or daughter craft from their stowed positions;
- Swinging cranes / derricks outboard over the water;
- Deploying stability pontoons;
- Building scaffolding outboard over a vessels side;
- Load testing of cranes over the quay or water;
- Testing equipment that extends over the water.

Masters are also responsible for ensuring that any third-party operations conducted on board their vessel comply with these requirements.

Vessel Owners, Operators, Agents, Berth Operators etc should ensure that the contents of this Navigation Notice are made known to the Masters of their vessels.
