

Navigation Notice No 24 of 2023 Amended Emergency Repairs to Aberdeen North Pier

Amendments are in red

Notice is hereby given that emergency repairs will commence on the North Pier from today 26th October 2023.

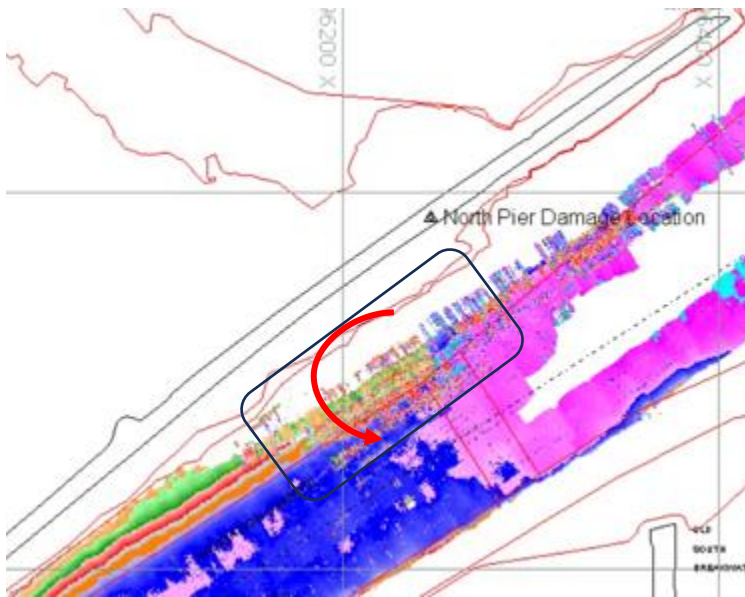
The North Pier has been damaged in the section marked on the chart.



Assessments and temporary repair of the damage will be ongoing throughout today and the following days. Measures will be taken to ensure that any delays to traffic is minimised. The Channel has been surveyed and there has been no change of depth observed in the area adjacent to the damage.

During the periods where the water level is above the damaged section it has been observed by the pilots that vessels may experience a push to the south of the channel in the area adjacent to the damaged section.

The recent port survey shows the approximately area that the push may be experienced during certain weather and tidal conditions. The approximated water flow can be seen shown by the red arrow.



There are no current restrictions on traffic movements associated with this assessment and repair process.

The temporary repair will continue to take place over the coming days weather permitting. Mariners may see a rock slope extending from the breakwater to towards the channel. This rock does not extend into the Navigation Channel and does not affect the navigation channel depth
